



The Country Club – Brookline, Massachusetts

Director of Club Operations

Founded in 1882, The Country Club is the oldest country club in America and a founding member of the United States Golf Association. This prestigious club holds an important place in golf history as the site of the 1999 Ryder Cup Matches as well as three U. S. Open Championships: the 1913 Championship won by Francis Ouimet and two others in 1963 and 1988. In 2022, The Country Club will host its 4th U.S. Open Championship and 16th USGA Championship. The successful candidate is expected to participate as a key team member for these important events.

The Country Club operates year-round and provides many seasonal sporting facilities including 27 holes of golf, five indoor tennis courts, four outdoor tennis courts, paddle & squash courts, an Olympic-sized swimming pool with a café, curling, croquet, fitness, skeet shooting, skating, and hockey. Its historic Clubhouse hosts three à la carte dining rooms and banquet venues, hosting up to 300, and five guest rooms. Recent capital projects include renovation of the Open Course by architect Gil Hanse and the building of a multipurpose building containing fitness, indoor golf practice facilities and a committee meeting room slated to open in July 2017.

The Director of Club Operations reports to the Assistant General Manager and supervises the following departments with full P&L accountability: housekeeping, locker rooms, overnight rooms, front desk, food service, beverage, and staff housing. This position manages clubhouse operations and facilities consistent with the direction and policies established by The Club. The Director of Clubhouse Operations oversees a staff of 120 year-round employees and 300 during the summer; he/she will hire, train and lead all staff within Clubhouse operations including assistant managers and department heads. The Director of Club Operations is expected to be engaged with the management team acting collaboratively with the CFO, Director of Golf and Fitness, Director of Aquatics and Curling, Director of Facilities, and Director of Culinary Operations.

This position requires a strong and personable leader to oversee and coach a talented and enthusiastic team and direct them to greater heights; executing first class programming and services and providing excellent facilities while demonstrating strong financial acumen is expected from the Director of Club Operations.

The successful candidate should have a four-year degree in hospitality management or equivalent accompanied by a proven record of success in high end private club food and beverage. Additionally, a successful candidate will match a congenial personality with a dedicated drive for excellence.

Compensation: The Club will offer competitive compensation, along with standard benefits. The Country Club has secured housing off premise for reasonable consideration which will be offered to the successful candidate.
